





Changes to data entry

Data-entry platform changes



- From July we are moving to a new more flexible data entry platform.
- Data entry will remain largely the same on the updated webtool and you and your team will be automatically moved over, however there are some things to check before July.

Actions for you:

- ☐ Make sure the list of users registered for your team is up to date
- ☐ Make sure there is a **lead** and **second lead** registered for your team
- ☐ Let us know if anyone should be removed from your team list
- ☐ Make sure your registered email address is correct
- ☐ Check that everyone who should have access to SSNAP has a unique account set up

Changing datasets:

| Period | Data locking deadline | Dataset |
|-----------------------|-----------------------|----------|
| Jan-March | May | Existing |
| Apr-Jun | Aug | Existing |
| <mark>Jul-</mark> Sep | Nov | New |

- Therefore, there will be a brief period where you may be entering data for patients on both datasets.
- For data entry from 1st July you will not have to enter therapy days, applicability and minutes for the EXISTING dataset.

For importing teams



The updated Import/Export Specification will be made available in April for importing teams.



We will provide the csv. and the import rules as before. We will not be syncing via an EPR system.



Only the first hospital treating a patient can use the import function. From July, this will include community teams.
