Introduction to this dataset

From 1 October 2024, the datasets for inpatient and community teams separated to allow for each dataset to be more closely tailored to the differing requirements of the inpatient and community settings and so two datasets were created: the Core Inpatient Dataset and the Core Community Dataset. The Core Six Month Assessment Dataset (this document) will remain a standalone document.

The SSNAP webtool has multiple validations (based on information supplied by teams in the preceding pathway and in preceding questions) and so some fields will either be pre-populated and/or unavailable to answer because they are not relevant.

The provider performing the six month assessment completes section 8 of the dataset.
