Survey Results

This report sets out the final results from the Stroke Patient Reported Experience Measures (PREMs) Survey 2022/23, ordered in exactly the same way as in the survey questionnaire completed by respondents.

Fieldwork for this survey was carried out between 16th January 2023 and 18th April 2023.

Reading the columns of figures

The results are shown firstly in absolute numbers then as percentage responses.

Conventions

The percentages are calculated after excluding those respondents that did not answer that particular question. All percentages are rounded to the nearest whole number. When added together, the percentages for all answers to a particular question may not total 100% because of this rounding.

On some questions there are also some figures/responses which are marked with an asterisk. These figures have been recalculated to exclude responses where the question was not applicable to the respondent's circumstances, or they felt unable to give a definite answer.

Example

For example, on questions such as Q2. 'Have you had more than one stroke? This could include a TIA or mini stroke', those not answering (Missing) and those saying "Not sure" are excluded from the percentage calculated for the asterisked responses.
